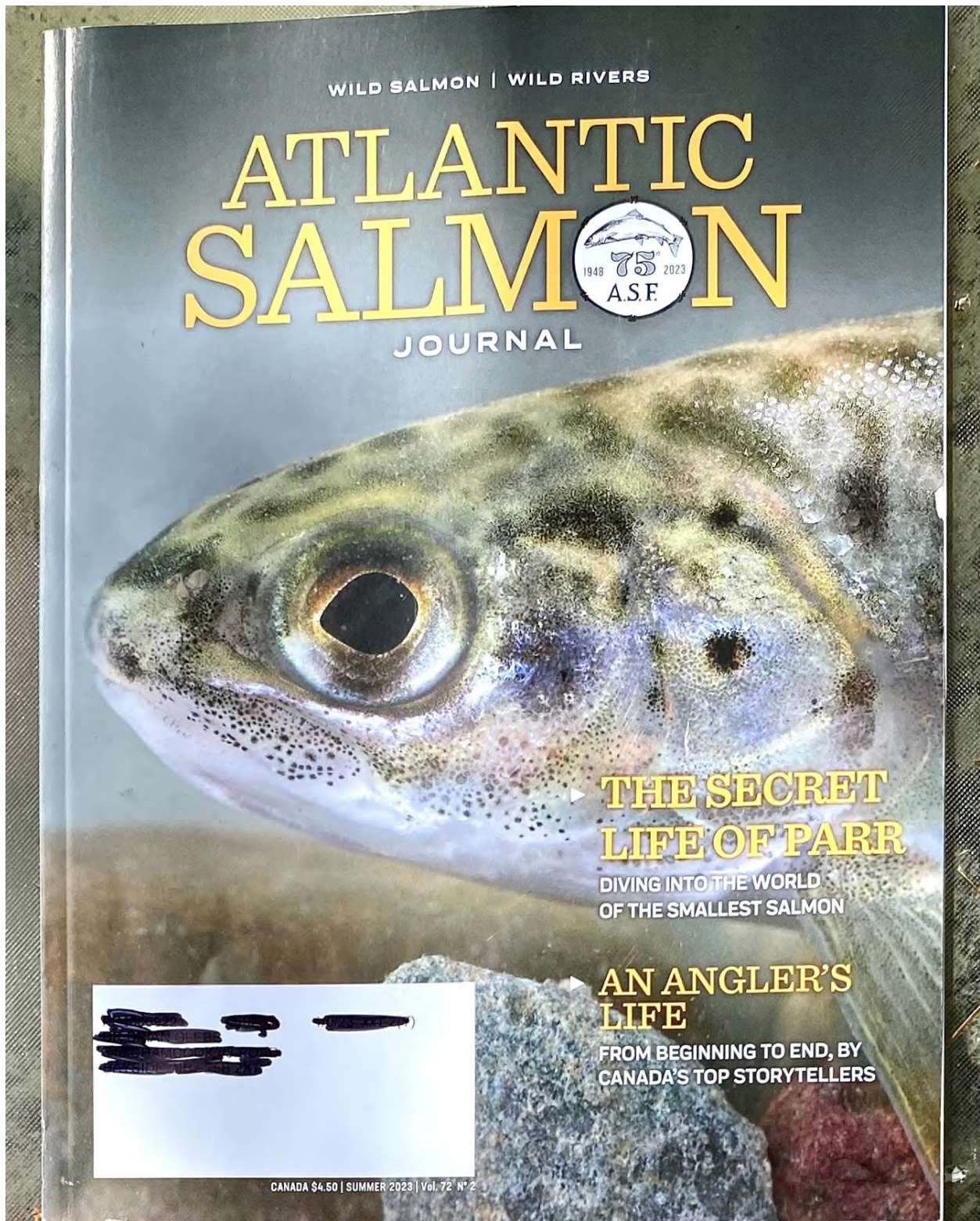




Diseased, Drugged, Dyed.
